1. Glorifies Jesus & Father

- Holy Spirit = Spiritual Superiority

- 1. The Holy Spirit is a gift given to all believers in Jesus without exception, and no conditions are placed upon this gift except faith in Christ (John 7:37-39).**

2. The Holy Spirit is given at the moment of salvation (Ephesians 1:13). Galatians 3:2 emphasizes this same truth, saying that the sealing and indwelling of the Spirit took place at the time of believing.

- **3. The Holy Spirit indwells believers permanently. The Holy Spirit is given to believers as a down payment, or verification of their future glorification in Christ (2 Corinthians 1:22; Ephesians 4:30).**

- **4. The Holy Spirit may or may not reveal Himself through miraculous abilities. He will speak in other languages or prophecy through believers at His discretion to meet the needs of the time. Believers have no say in the matter. Miraculous ability is neither learned nor acquired, but solely a work of God.**

- **5. While miraculous ability validates the presence of the Holy Spirit we cannot interpret the absence of miracles as the absence of the Spirit. In the OT and NT the effects of the Spirit's work in the lives of God's people take a variety of forms. The Spirit's presence results in wisdom, understanding, strength and fear of God (Isaiah 11:2).**

- **15 The people were waiting expectantly and were all wondering in their hearts if John might possibly be the Messiah. 16 John answered them all, “I baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.**

- **Repentance is not enough without trust in Christ.** It is a necessary beginning but by itself doesn't save a person from the eternal consequences of sin. **One must believe in the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ and accept God's forgiveness as a free gift apart from good deeds.**
