






would the sense of hearing be?**




**If the whole body were an ear,

where would the body be?**




**As it is, there are many parts,
but one body.**


**The eye cannot say to the hand,

On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and the parts that we think are less honorable we treat with special honor.




And the parts that are unrepresentable are treated with special modesty, while our representable parts need no special treatment. But God has put the body together, giving greater honor to the parts that

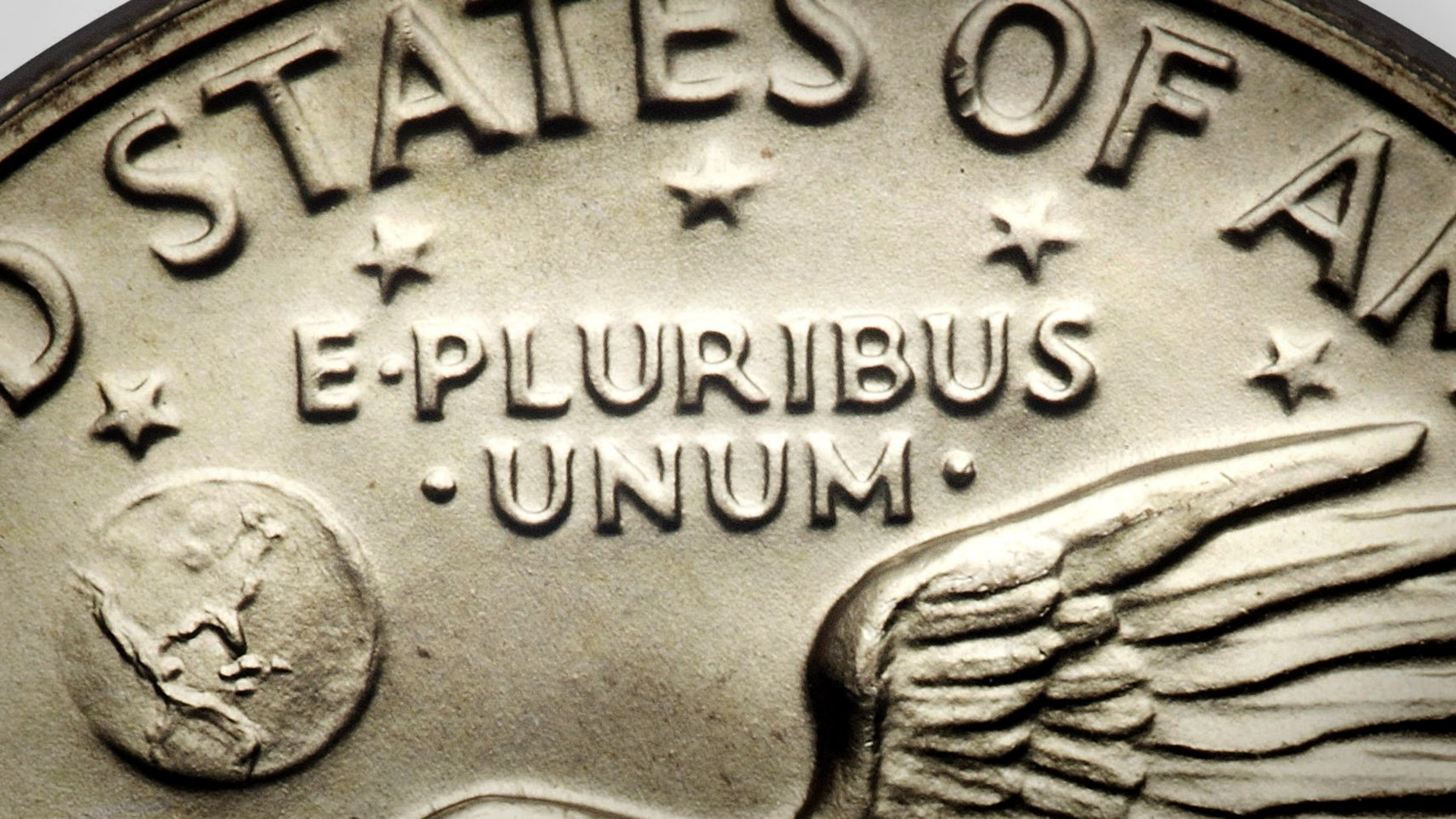


