








⁷ Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.



11 You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.


12 This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of the Lord's people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God.

10 Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.




Generosity Involves... Giving something that is of value to me Giving unselfishly Giving above and beyond

"...will result in thanksgiving to God" (v. 11)


"...overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God" (v. 12)

"...others will praise God" (v. 13)




Giving without grace, people only see you and your efforts.
