Injustice is the exact opposite of how God wants it to be.

Luke 4:14-20 Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside. He was teaching in their synagogues, and everyone praised him.

He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read,

"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the

to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him.

Sight to the blind


Set the oppressed free

Did Jesus come to end physical oppression as well?








