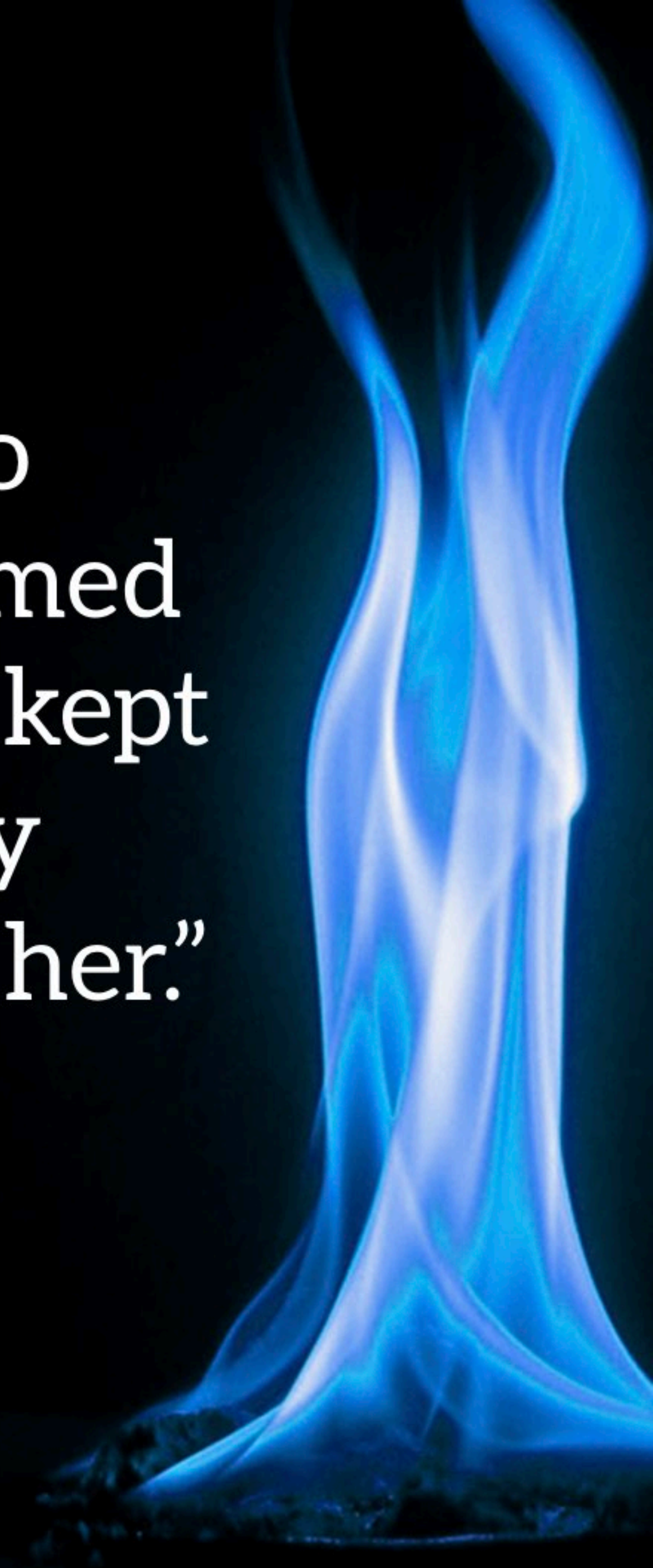

When she knew she was pregnant, she began to despise her mistress.



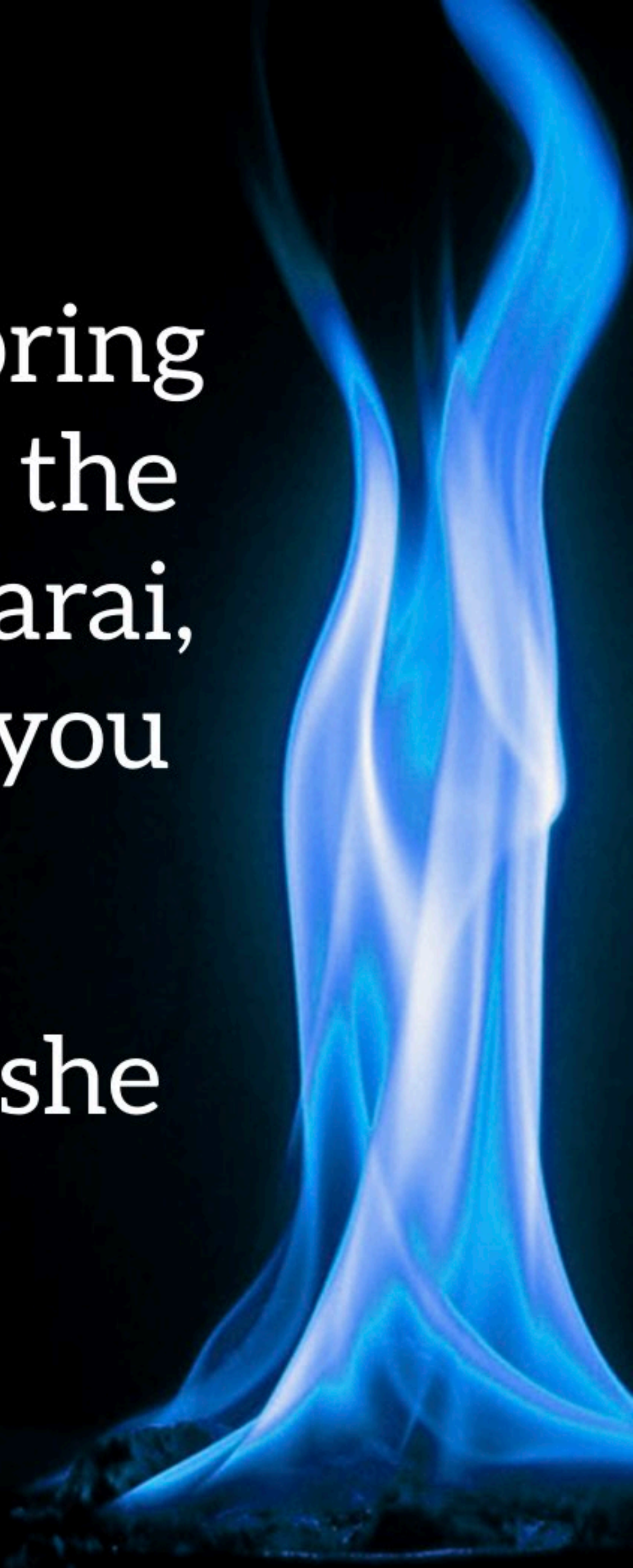

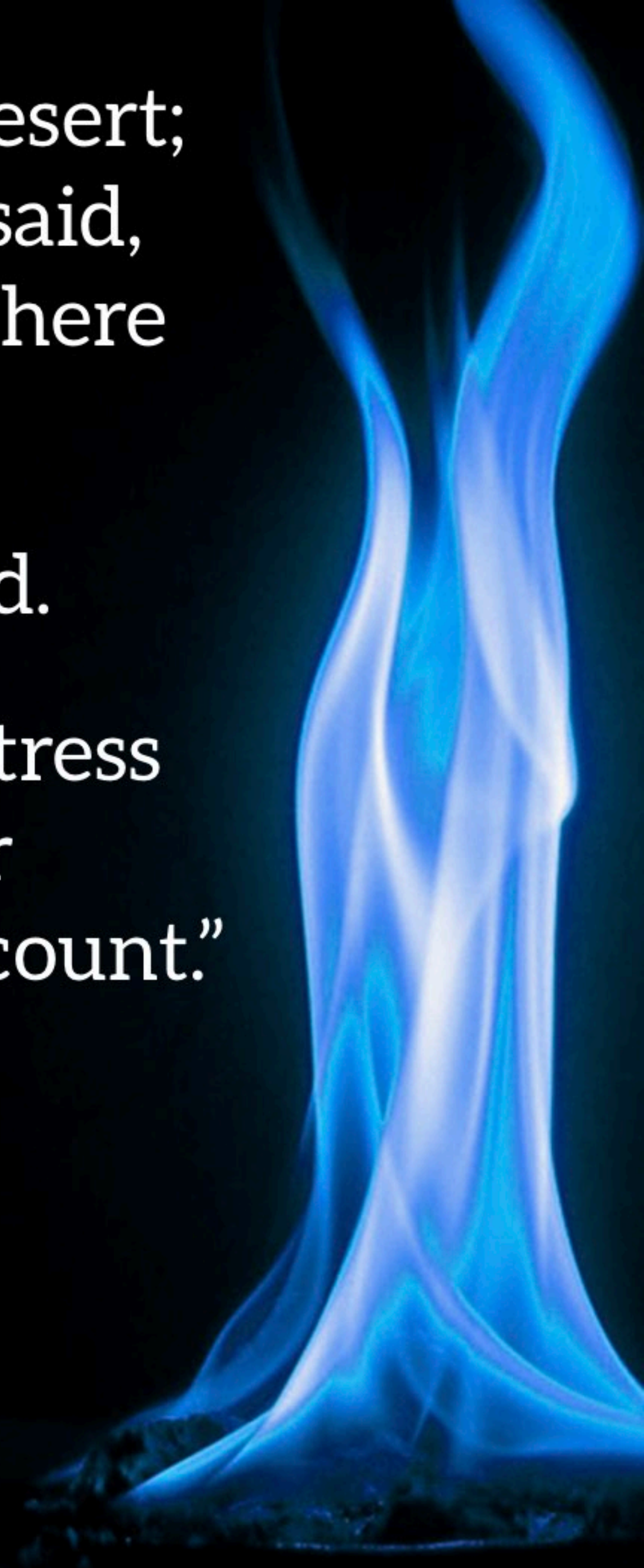

Ishmael to the son she had borne.



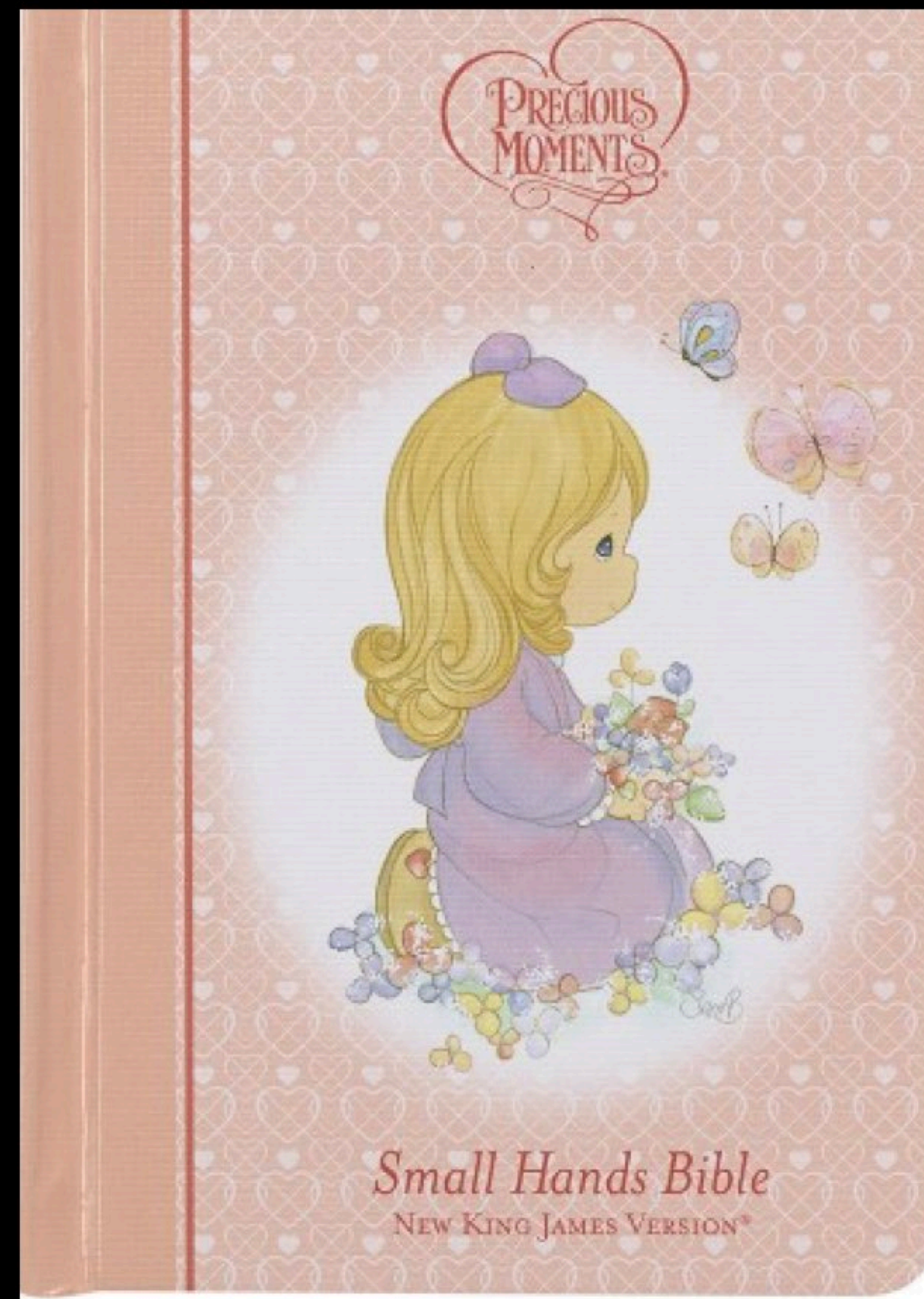
