Romans 3:23-26 NGT  
“For all have sinned and fall short  
of God’s glory. Yet, they are  
justified freely by *His* grace  
through the redemption that is in  
*Christ Jesus*.”



God publicly put forth  
Jesus as the mercy seat, accessible  
through faith in *His blood* and  
providing proof of God's covenant justice  
when, in God's forbearance, He passed  
over the sins previously committed.



*This was to demonstrate His covenant justice in the present time so that **He would be just and the justifier** and declare to be in the right everyone who trusts in Jesus' faithfulness."*
